PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The aim of the Park Ridge State High School Academic Excellence Program (IGNITE) is to develop lifelong learners with digital literacies and 21st century skills that will prepare them for the careers of the future. This is achieved through an innovative approach to teaching and learning built to meet the needs of the extension learner and provide this student with the skills to meet the demands of a complex technology based global workforce. The program provides the learner with unique and engaging learning opportunities that provide a divergent approach to the mainstream curriculum.

IGNITE is designed to provide a clear pathway for students who are committed to academic endeavours and the pursuit of a university education. Our curriculum encourages students to:

- Engage in unique learning opportunities and challenging work environments
- Use enhanced critical thinking skills
- Explore project based learning tasks
- Develop collaborative partnerships and a team ethos
- Become conversant and competent in the integration of technology
- * Reach their potential through guided individual learning pathways

Students in the program will study all core subjects (Maths, Science, History and English) in a streamed class of high achieving students until the end of year 9 or as long as they maintain program requirements.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Entry into IGNITE will be open to students from the end of Year 5. Students should demonstrate a proven record of high performance that demonstrates proficiency in or across academic fields of the curriculum such as Mathematics, Science, English, SOSE, or excellence across the curriculum spectrum. Students are likely to be high performing and ultimately university bound.

Due to the accelerated nature of the IGNITE program, we require that students in the program:

- ❖ Are passing the four core subjects English, Maths, Science,
- SOSE (A and B level results would be preferred)
- ❖ Have an attendance rate of at least 92%
- Complete all homework and class activities
- Submit assessment drafts for feedback and complete assessment tasks by the due dates
- ❖ Demonstrate respect for the learning of themselves and others within the classroom
- Present a positive attitude towards all learning activities
- Arrive to class on time
- Participate in learning activities both during and outside of classtime

- Provide a caring and supportive learning environment to maximise success
- Expect high standards of behaviour, dress and attendance
