WHAT IS IMEX?(Instrumental Music Excellence)

- **Entry into the IMEX program grants entry into the IGNITE program (academic excellence program), streaming students together for all core subjects (Math, English, History & Science).**
- **Overseas tour every 4 years. We have previously travelled to New Zealand in 2017, this year (due to Covid) we will be doing an Outback QLD tour! Our next trip will be in 2025 which will be selected from Hawaii, Japan, New Zealand, Vanuatu, Fiji, Tonga, Vienna or USA.**
- **Students will participate in 3 x 70 minute intense musical lessons a week. During these lessons they will explore: performance technique, in depth analysis of musical elements and compositional techniques; varying from traditional classical music, to popular music.**
- **Performance opportunities with our award winning ensembles and conductors including – 70 piece wind symphony, 110 piece concert band, two jazz ensembles, two string ensembles and two Percussion ensembles. Many other groups will be developed in the coming years.**
