

UNIFORM POLICY

Dress Code

As all students are expected to maintain a standard of personal presentation that reflects positively on our school, the following are not acceptable:

- mohawk and other extreme hairstyles or colours
- excessive make-up (including Gothic style, eye makeup & nail polish)
- facial piercing and especially those considered unsafe for workplace health and safety

Jewellery

Students are permitted to wear a plain watch, one small ring, studs or sleepers. Other items must be removed in the interest of workplace health and safety requirements at school.

DAY UNIFORM

1. Unisex Polo Shirt
 - a) Unisex collared polo shirt
 - b) **Yr 7, 8 & 9** – Black panel front and back, green sleeves with self-cuffs. White curved stripe front and back, single green side panel. Green collar with white stripe then black edge.
 - c) **Yr 10, 11 & 12** – Bottle green panel front and back, black sleeves with self-cuffs. White curved strip front and back, single black side panel. Black collar with white stripe then green edge.
 - d) Embroidered school logo on left breast, black and white version

2. Unisex Shorts
 - a) Black Microfibre
 - b) 2 front slash pockets
 - c) 1 zipped security pocket
 - d) Embroidered PRSHS Logo – lower right leg

3. Boys' Shorts
 - a) Black poly-viscose ('gab' weave) shorts, fly front
 - b) Side pockets with zip
 - c) Belt tabs
 - d) Back pocket with Velcro flap
 - e) No pinstripes

4. Skirt
 - a) Black poly-cotton (prestalene)
 - b) Two inverted pleats front
 - c) No waist band
 - d) Side zip pocket

5. Long pants
(*track pants can be purchased from school*)
 - a) **Plain black business trousers** (boys), fly front
 - b) **Plain black pants** (girls) to top of shoe & properly hemmed, no gathering at hem, no ribbons or bows or tight fitting pants
 - c) **Plain black Track Pants**
 - d) No denim, cargo style, bike pants or leggings
 - e) No contrast trim or midriff
 - f) No pinstripes
 - g) If a belt is required, it must be a plain business style belt black with an unobtrusive buckle

6. Footwear
 - a) Plain black, plain white or a combination of black & white closed shoes with same coloured laces, leather, suede or vinyl and NO inappropriate symbols
 - b) Shoe must be fully enclosed and have an impervious top **NB: must NOT have a canvas or mesh upper**
 - c) NO ballet flats, NO boots or high tops
 - d) Plain white socks, covering ankles
 - e) Black or Flesh stockings/tights (with inbuilt foot) optional for girls (to be worn with skirt ONLY)

7. Winter
 - a) Pullover – plain bottle green only (NOT BLACK or any other colour) V-neck with School Logo
 - b) Microfibre jacket (school design only)
 - c) Seniors Jersey (Year 12 only) negotiated annually with students through Year Coordinator



FORMAL UNIFORM (to be worn in its entirety for representative or dress occasions)

1. Shirt/Blouse
 - a) White poly-cotton (208) standard collared business shirt (boys) with logo on breast pocket
2. Tie
 - b) White poly-cotton (208) collared button up blouse (girls) with logo on pocket, straight hem, hip length
3. Black trousers/ pants (*as for Day uniform*) or Skirt
 - c) Tie (green, diagonal black & white stripe)
 - d) Metal school badge optional on tie

4. Footwear
 - a) Black dress shoes (closed)
 - b) Black socks or stockings with trousers/pants
 - c) Black OR Flesh stockings/tights, white socks with skirt ONLY (girls)
