

WHAT IS STUDIED IN GERMAN?

Then students will create an advertising campaign to attract our overseas visitors. Students will also investigate the different types of foods, recipes, culture, TV and the media in Germany and Australia and create a Variety Show to be presented at the Southern Cluster Cultural Festival. Students will also attend the German film festival held every year in April and the Oktoberfest for Teens at the RNA Showgrounds in October.

WHAT IS STUDIED IN INDONESIAN?


Australia has become one of the major tourist destinations in the world. Using virtual tours and internet sites we'll investigate the world of travel – in Australia, Indonesia and other countries. Then students will explore creative and interactive ways in advertising and attracting overseas visitors. Students will also investigate the different types of foods, recipes, culture, TV and the media in Indonesian and Australia and create a Variety Show to be presented at the Southern Cluster Cultural Festival. Students may have the opportunity to attend the Indonesian Camp, BBQ Picnic, Indonesian workshops at Brisbane Power House and Indonesian Restaurant.

HOW WILL YOU LEARN?

WHY CHOOSE ART?

WHAT IS STUDIED?

An understanding of visual literacy enables students to be able to make sense of their environment. In Visual Art students transform their visual perception and ideas into expression in a material form, via experiences with a variety of media in two and three dimensions and digital experiences.

Students will experience different Artistic media such as:

Painting ● Clay Work ● Printmaking ● Drawing

HOW WILL YOU LEARN?

Through practical and theory lessons students will develop their skills in three areas – Folio of drawings and research – visual diary, art pieces and Responding (evaluation/reviews of art work).




HOW WILL YOU LEARN?

Design and technology – Food and nutrition 'Foods from other cultures'

WHY CHOOSE 'Foods from other cultures'? Every day we eat foods that originate in other cultures. We use different preparation techniques to explore the tastes of Italy, China, France and other countries. Do you want to go on a cultural journey? Take the time to explore and experience the world of food.

WHAT IS STUDIED?

"Food from other cultures" investigates the variety of foods eaten in Australia and how to use the foods in a healthy Australian Diet. Students explore the world of food and how different cultures meet their food requirements. They design foods that link Australian foods to other cultures and how the foods have influenced what we eat today. Students produce food from other cultures.

HOW WILL YOU LEARN?

Investigation to create designed solutions, using criteria for success to evaluate designs and producing high quality products safely and skilfully. Students will communicate and document projects and use management skills.

Design and technology – Fashion and textiles

WHY CHOOSE 'Fashion diva'? Want to know more about fashion and how to sew amazing designs in clothing? If you want to know more about the fashion or are thinking about a career in fashion, then this is the subject for you!

WHAT IS STUDIED?

"Fashion diva" Is the year 9 program that teaches students practical skills about clothing construction and fashion trends. 'Fashion diva encourages students to look at fashion trends and choose clothing that suits their body shapes. Students learn about fabrics and their suitability for clothing and how to sew and create clothing. This knowledge is linked to practical lessons.

HOW WILL YOU LEARN?

Investigations and practical work are two of our key ways of learning. Class work involves students designing, planning and problem solving, as well as evaluating their overall results.

Students will develop skills in metal fitting, sheet metal fabrication, metal machining, electronics and plastic fabrication. In conjunction with projects, students will complete related theory tasks based on projects to consolidate learning. Senior subject –Engineering Skills.

WHY CHOOSE HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION? HPE promotes the value of physical activity in student's lives. It gives student's opportunities to learn about and practice ways of working with others to adopt and maintain a healthy, productive and active lifestyle.

Practical sports may include: Soccer, Basketball, Touch Football, Netball, Futsal, Tennis, Gym, Athletics.


Theory units: First Aid and Injury Prevention, Sociology of Sport – Study of Sport in Australian Culture
