Pathway Options

Upon completion of the course, students are qualified to work as Assistants in Nursing (AIN) and Personal Care Workers (PCW), and can find employment in nursing homes, hospitals, and the NDIS support industry.

Students may also choose to work while continuing their education at TAFE (Diploma of Nursing) or at university (Bachelor of Nursing).
